### Foundation seeks to quench thirst, benefit children

The **foundation's** Junior Advisory Team, consisting of junior high and high school students, is coordinating the event, which raised more than \$4,000 last year, said **foundation** President Ruthe Rosen of Chino Hills.

"Last year, we had over 150 kids volunteering, and this year, we're hoping for even more," said Mrs. Rosen, who founded the organization after her daughter, Karla, died of cancer last year.
