GOLF TOURNAMENT TO BENEFIT THE LET IT BE FOUNDATION

Chino Hills, CA — Golfers of all ages will tee off at Los Serranos Golf & Country Club in Chino Hills on Feb. 11, 2008, for The Let It Be Foundation's first annual golf tournament. All funds raised at the event will benefit the foundation's goal of supporting Chino Valley families with children suffering from life-threatening medical conditions.

The "Let It Be Golf" Tournament: Play, Learn & Enjoy is open to adults and children ages 8 to 17. Registration begins at 9 a.m. and costs \$225 for adults and \$100 for children. A barbecue lunch and dinner buffet are included. The adult scramble begins at 11 a.m.

Youths will watch an instructional video on golf course conduct before golfing on a separate, nine-hole course, hit a bucket of balls on the driving range and play on the new waffle ball course. A high school or college golf team member and VIP chaperone will accompany each team in the youth scramble.

The tournament is limited to the first 144 adults and 72 youths, so early registration is encouraged. Non-playing guests are invited to attend the post-tournament dinner banquet for a fee of \$40.

"This event is another opportunity for us to bring people together to make our community a better place," said Steve Pendleton, golf tournament chairperson and foundation board member. Since the foundation's inception in 2006, it has supported 10 families with children who have life-threatening illnesses. Services available range from home maintenance and groceries to tutoring and transportation assistance.
