CALLING ALL ELEMENTARY AND JR. HIGH SCHOOLS: GET YOUR ACT TOGETHER!
CHINO, CA: The Let It Be Foundation is holding open auditions for its fourth annual “*KIDS 4 KIDS*” Community Talent Show, an event that showcases the talent of Chino Valley students while raising funds for local families caring for children with life-threatening illnesses.

For the first time, the show will include junior high students as well as elementary schoolchildren from across the Chino Valley. Participating Schools are asked to enter three to five student performers/groups in the show, but students from other schools may also try-out on their own at open auditions, March 10 from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. and on March 11 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at Wickman Elementary School, 16250 Pinehurst Dr. in Chino Hills. To qualify for an audition, you must attend a Chino Valley elementary or junior high school (public or private) or live in the Chino Valley and have an age-appropriate act that lasts no more than three minutes.

The talent show will take place on March 26-27 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. at the Chino Hills High School Theater. Proceeds from the event will fund bedroom makeovers for some of the children being served by the foundation along with other goals of the Jr. Advisory Team. In the past four years, the foundation’s Jr. Advisory Team, a group of high school and Jr. high students who organize this event, has raised over \$11,000 from the talent shows to redecorate the rooms of seven children who suffer from life-threatening illnesses.

Tickets for the event will be sold in advance and at the door. Tickets will be available at all participating schools, The Let It Be Foundation office, and online at www.theletitbefoundation.com/products.

“This show offers a unique opportunity to bring all of our schools together and promote the artistic talents of the children of our communities while providing much-needed support to the families our foundation serves,” said Ruthe Rosen, organization president.
